Reach University offers a job-embedded B.A. program for classified school employees, allowing them to earn credit for on-the-job experience and complete coursework via evening Zoom seminars for just \$75/month after aid. The Intern/M.A.T. program enables eligible bachelor's degree holders to teach full time while earning a credential and master's degree for \$7,500 per year. The Teacher Induction Program provides a two-year, mentor-supported pathway for new teachers aligned to California standards, with annual tuition of \$4,500–\$5,000 depending on the pathway.
